<b>Tissue Box Animals</b> Create your own Tissue Box Animals from materials around your house	<b>Disney Lip Sync</b> Think of your favourite song from a Disney movie, and record yourself lip syncing the chorus	<b>Play with Playdough</b> Find a recipe to make your own playdough, then use it to create a piece of art	<b>Terrific Tins</b> Clean and decorate an old can and use it as a pencil tin at home
<b>Word Maker</b> Make a list of at least 20 different words out of the letters found in the phrase ' <i>Term One Was Fun</i> '	<b>Cool Cooks</b> Find a vegetarian recipe online and a meal for your house. Make sure you have adult supervision while you cook.	<b>Crossword Creation</b> Pick out 10 items from your classroom and list them. Then make a crossword with hints for each answer.	<b>Wonderful Walk</b> Map out a 30 minute walk around your neighbourhood. Make sure to include photos or drawings of key landmarks.
<b>Copycat Art</b> Research a famous artwork and try to recreate it. You could choose to draw, paint or use objects around your home.	<b>Cheering Chalk</b> Use some coloured chalk to decorate the footpath in front of your house in the colours of your favourite sport team	<b>Happy Haiku</b> Write a Haiku poem about yourself	<b>Easter Collage</b> Look through catalogues you receive in the mail, and make an A4 collage full of different Easter eggs
